

JAZZ-THEMED PARTY IDEAS

Jazz-themed parties generally fall into one of two categories – traditional New Orleans style (birthplace of jazz) or upscale 1920's New York (think "Great Gatsby"). Other styles are possible, of course, which correlate with various eras in the history of jazz, such as the 1930's Cuban/Latin influence, the 1940's swing band era, the 1950's "cool" / Beatnik styles, and the late 1960's free jazz or jazz/rock fusion influences.

Food

New Orleans Style

Boiled crawfish, raw oysters, jambalaya, red beans, dirty rice, seafood gumbo, shrimp etouffee', shrimp or oyster po' boys, blackened fish, bourbon chicken, corn maque choux salad, and pralines, beignets, or bananas Foster for dessert. New York Style

- Champagne (especially when oysters are served)
- Bloody Mary (again, especially with oysters)
- Gin Rickey (gin, lime, seltzer)
- Mint Julep (bourbon, mint, sugar, seltzer)
- Sazerac (Absinthe, simple syrup, bitters, rye whiskey)
- Cafe' Brulot (Cognac, Cointreau, brown sugar, cinnamon, clove, & chickory coffee)
- Lemonade

Decorations & Fashion

New Orleans Style (color scheme: purple, green, & gold)

Masks, decorative parasols, beads, urns & ferns, mock streetlamps, three-piece suits, striped shirts & suspenders.

New York Style (color scheme: black, white, & gold)

Anything art deco style, flapper feathers & beads, gangster zoot suits, speakeasy décor, vintage posters.
